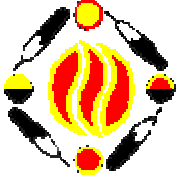
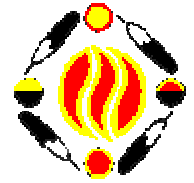

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the application using a typewriter or pen. Make sure you have completed the application and have answered all of the questions. Sign your name and date the bottom of the page.
2. Request that your high school transcript be sent to the Admissions Office at Bay Mills Community College.
3. No application fee is required with this application.

ADMISSIONS POLICY

BMCC practices an open door admission policy by providing educational programs to individuals regardless of their academic backgrounds. Students seeking admission to degree and certificate programs are required to submit High School transcripts or proof of GED completion. Students without a high school diploma who are at least eighteen years of age are admitted under Special Student Status, and allowed one year to complete their high school diploma or GED.

TRANSFER APPLICANTS

Applicants are admitted to advanced standing upon presentation of an official transcript of credits earned from another college. Credit will be granted to the extent that the subjects for which credit is requested are parallel in content and intensity to the subjects offered at BMCC. Transfer of credit toward any certificate or degree program will be limited to 40 percent of the total number of credit hours for that diploma.

ORIENTATION AND REGISTRATION

All new and transfer students are encouraged to participate in orientation activities. Orientation is held on campus and other locations each semester as part of the registration process. The session features orientation to the college, pre-registration advisement and an opportunity to meet other students, faculty and staff.

Registration means officially signing up for classes and paying for them. This occurs during designated times prior to each semester. The current class schedule will list registration dates, times, and procedures.

FINANCIAL AID

To apply for financial aid, students must obtain a financial aid packet from the Financial Aid Office, complete the forms and submit the packet according to the instructions and deadlines. Students must also submit to the Financial Aid Office all requested documents needed to complete their financial aid file.
